# PLANTING & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- ☞ Plant your small fruiting plants in full sun or part shade. These plants will grow to 3' to 4' or more.
- ☞ Dig a hole that's twice as wide as the container. Place the plant in the hole, surround with soil and cover the roots to the same soil level as it was in the container. Make sure not to plant it too deep. Add water and allow the soil to settle around the roots. Fill in any void areas with additional soil to make sure that there are no roots exposed.
- ☞ Follow a regular watering schedule and feed your plants with an acid-loving plant fertilizer. Most edibles need well-drained, rich acidic soils that are well-mulched. Most edibles have shallow roots so they need a good mulch covering to protect the roots. Check with your local nursery professional for additional care and feeding instructions.
